


What is ENERMASS?

- SUDOE area: South West Europe, Spain, Portugal, South western regions of France and Great Britain (only Gibraltar)
- Enermass Budget: 1.169M € (75% ERDF). Cofinanced by ERDF (FEDER) Funds: European Regional Development Fund

Create a transnational cluster on energetic valorization of biomass

“A cluster is a group of companies sharing local resources, using similar technologies, and forming linkages and alliances. These linkages can take for instance the form of buyer-supplier relationships, joint marketing, training, or research initiatives, associations, and lobbying”

ENERMASS cluster services...

- ❖ Detect innovative projects and helps them at the starting phases
- ❖ Ensure an activity of prospection and lobbying
- ❖ Help writing agreements, intellectual property non discloser agreements to its associates or to enterprises demanding its services
- ❖ Facilitate a better access to funding
- ❖ Attribute quality labels to proposed services
- ❖ Provide a quality formation and training activity

- To the 31st December 2014




- **Two consecutive steps in a roll:**

- Working in a cluster-like approach
- Creating a legal structure

- **Why can it be effective ?**

- The cluster will take advantage of the results of the first stage
- Some assets will be transferred to the new organization, so as to boost its launch



TRAINING

- Enermass International Course - « Pilot course » leaded by UM2
- Define a module of theoretical courses, a practical course (visits) and determine a number of hours
- Develop a MOOC Massive Open Online Course this year in English
- Results of the Enermass survey to adapt the course to different targets
